Information and Communication Technologies are any electronic device or related applications which allow users to record, send, access or receive information, in textual, audio, image or video form. These may include but are not restricted to:

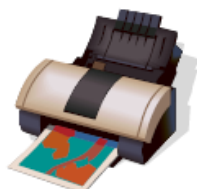
- computer systems and related applications such as email and internet

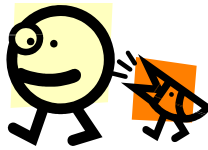

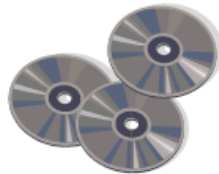

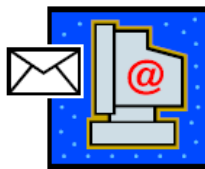
