- Removal of the cricket nets
- •Installation of fencing along the top of the retaining wall near the COLA
- •Installation of approx 650 sq metres of artificial turf along along the top section of
- Installation of approximately 120 sq metres of outdoor carpet in the breezeway
- Re-painting of existing playground markings
- •Painting of fresh designs and games as playground markings
- Purchasing of more balls and smaller equipment for the students to use during

- •We respect the No Parking signs in the car park.



Kindergarten - Denim shorts or skirt, red, white or green shirt, a Santa hat, reindeer ears or bells headband.


- **Year 1** Boys- red Christmas shirt, Girls- green Christmas shirt. All wear Santa hat.




