IMPETIGO ALERT

We have received notification of a reported case of Impetigo (school sores) in the school. Impetigo is a highly contagious type of skin infection. The infection is characterised by inflamed blisters that pop, weep and form crusts. A child with Impetigo should be kept home from school until appropriate treatment has begun and the sores on exposed areas are covered with a waterproof dressing and where necessary a crepe bandage. Should your child present symptoms of Impetigo please see your doctor.
