PHYSICAL EDUCATION / HEALTH / MUSIC FOR 2018

As mentioned previously in newsletters, this year there has been a change in the classes offered to the children to replace Creative Arts from last year during Release from Face to Face teaching (RFF). RFF is an award condition provided to all teaching staff for planning and preparation for teaching. This year, we have moved our focus from Creative and Visual Arts to include Physical Education, Health and Music. The logistics of this change is a little different from previous years as each class is taken separately for each lesson and each lesson lasts for one hour. As a result, the students will receive two lessons in each of these areas every three weeks as it is a rotating timetable. The length of each lesson is kept at one hour to minimise the time lost when transitioning between classes. Visual Arts will now be taught by the classroom teachers in their regular teaching program throughout the year. This is an exciting new direction for Corpus Christi which will ensure that the knowledge and skills of Physical Education, Health and Music are taught to all students through an explicit structured curriculum.
