The Premier's Reading Challenge aims to encourage a love of reading and to enable students to experience quality literature by reading from a vast list of recommended books. The challenge is for students to read more and to read more widely by exposing them to many different authors.

Students can borrow PRC books from the School Library as well as Penrith Library and its other Branches.

Students keep a reading log online and submit entries directly through the Premier's Reading Challenge website which they can access from home at anytime. The challenge runs from 4th March to 30th August 2019.

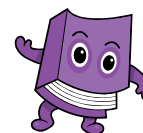

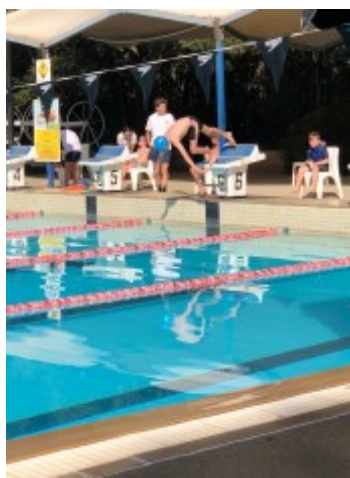


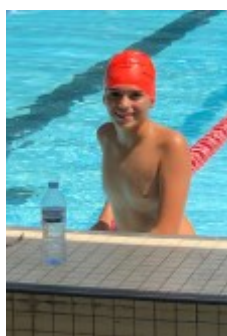
