This week all of the children have been involved with learning in Numeracy based on Geometric Reasoning. This has allowed our students to refine their reasoning and communicating skills while learning more about two dimensional shapes. This learning has supported our school goal and has seen development in the way the children have shared their ideas and reasoned through problems.

We have had the support of our teacher educator from CEDP who has presented professional learning, planned and programmed and taught with our teachers. Together with this support we have received feedback so that we can implement further reasoning and communicating into our daily numeracy time.

Charvi "2D shapes are flat. A 12 sided shape is a dodecagon."

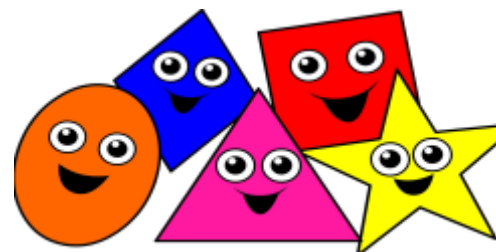
Michael "rectangles have 2 sets of parallel lines."

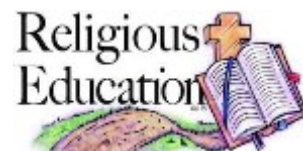

Vinnies Return and Earn

The NSW State Government launched the Return and Earn Container Deposit Scheme (CDS) in late 2017 in an effort to address drink container litter, which makes up 44% of the volume of all litter in the state. Vinnies participation in the scheme expands on its ethos and ongoing commitment to recycling, and is an extension of their retail store philosophy of reuse – helping to divert waste from landfill and supporting those in need at the same time. The program provides Vinnies with an additional revenue stream to help fund its Good Works within communities across NSW, receiving a handling fee for every container processed.

As part of our ongoing commitment to sustainability we will be supporting the return and earn scheme through Vinnies. Two bins will be established in our school for the collection of containers. All proceeds will be going directly to Vinnies. The bins will be delivered next week.



This term we will be focusing on gathering our donations for the St Vincent de Paul winter appeal. We reach out through 'Sockeanies' so remember to send in scarves, beanies, gloves and socks for all those who will be suffering through the winter months. These donations will be given to St. Vincent de Paul at our Week 10 assembly.

Literacy at Corpus Christi

What's been happening in Year 2?

Since the beginning of term 2, Year 2 have been interacting with each other during Literacy Groups through 'Readers Theatre' and Persuasive language tasks. Readers Theatre is a written script with a storyline that children read and act out in a performance. The children in Year 2 have been working on the projection and expression of their voice when performing Readers Theatre in their classrooms.

During Literacy Groups they have also been working on the oral rehearsal of persuasive topics in order to persuade an audience to agree or disagree with them. Some topics link to their science unit about weather and which is the best season and why?

The Learning Intention for Oral Language in Year 2 is: We are learning to understand how language is used to effectively communicate with others. They have been unpacking the use of facial expressions, gestures, using a clear voice to present formal presentations and the difference when working in a small group compared to when presenting to the grade.

Great effort Year 2. It has been a lot of fun teaching you all and watching your oral language skills develop!

Mathematics at Corpus Christi

What's been happening across the school?

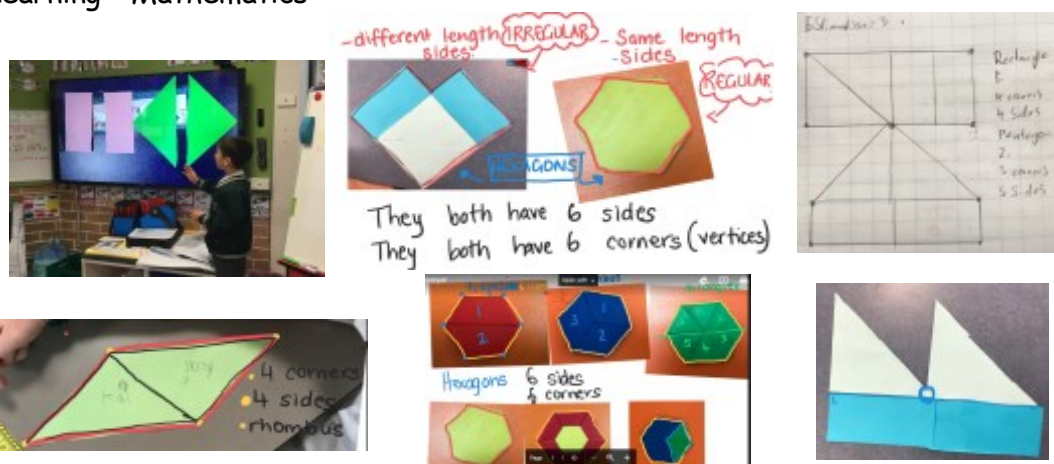
During this week the whole school from K-6 have been learning about communicating and reasoning when exploring the properties of 2D shapes. This learning module, Geometric Reasoning has been very challenging and exciting for all the teachers and students.

To kick start the module, all students were asked to make as many shapes as they could using 2 rectangles and 2 triangles (cut from folding two squares two different ways). Kindy learnt how to cut a square in half and make a new shape, Year 1 cut two squares in half two different ways to make a new shape, Year 2 cut two shapes and named the shapes, Year 3 cut the two squares, named the new shape and properties, Year 4 looked further at noticing parallel lines, vertices and special quadrilaterals, Year 5 have been exploring the 2D shapes beyond 8 sides and their features and Year 6 were measuring the angles within the shapes.

WOW, such a progression of learning and so exciting to hear the students explain what they were thinking when applying the rule: When sides meet, they must be of the same length.

Their *Driving Question* was: *How does heating and cooling change the state of solids and liquids?* During the unit, the students engaged in an experiment where they needed to use the information they had learnt in order to make SLIME. They needed to decide on the ingredients, the quantity and method. Year 3 had lots of fun and evaluated their experiment at the conclusion.
