
## What is Assessment?

Assessment for our young students today looks very different for parents who were only students a couple of decades ago. And whilst we are all familiar with the A-E grading system from our own education, the interpretation of the grades is different now.

Learners of the 21st Century are being taught the outcomes and content from the NSW syllabus. These outcomes guide our teaching, and are reconstructed as a "Learning Intention" as seen in all classrooms. The content as directed by the outcomes, becomes the learning for our students, known as "Success Criteria."

How the students respond to the learning is assessed by teachers daily, weekly, at the end of a cycle of learning, part way through a project, feedback, end product and many more. Teachers take anecdotal notes, mark and moderate student books, record conversations and thinking to "assess" the success of learning for a student.


Taking in from the already mentioned, here are examples of a model used to explain assessment, including self and peer assessment:







Here are some examples of what you may see in your child's books or in their classrooms. (Note the activity is only one part of the success criteria seen and highlighted).












