Tips for Conversation Starters

with your Kids !

As we begin the school year together, you will definitely be wanting to know how your child is settling into the new learning space and school routines. Asking your child about their day is an important activity of an afternoon. Here are some suggestions for promoting conversation about the school day:

- 1. What was the hardest thing you had to do today?
- 2.Did any of your classmates or teacher do anything funny?
- 3.Tell me about what you read in class.
- 4. What's the biggest difference between this year and last year?
- 5. What rules are different at school than our rules at home?
- 6.Can you show me something you learned (or did) today?
- 7. What did you do today that made your brain work really hard?
- 8.Where's the best place to play at playtime?

Enjoy the conversation with your child and share some things about your day too!

COMMUNICATION

Staff at Corpus Christi recognise that email is a fast and convenient way to communicate. As you can appreciate, teachers read their emails at various times throughout the school day. BUILDING CHILD SAFE COMMUNITIES

'Building Child Safe Communities' is an initiative developed by Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta that enhances our commitment to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all students in our care. It is a requirement that all volunteers and contractors complete an online form that confirms expectations in relation to behaviour whilst volunteering or contracting at schools, Catholic Out of Schools Hours Care and Catholic Early Learning Centres.



This form also seeks to determine the suitability of volunteers and contractors by requiring them to declare that they do not have a criminal history involving children. Volunteers – please click on 'Building Child Safe Communities – Undertaking for Volunteers' or access the form via the Catholic Education Diocese of Parramatta public webpage http://www.parra.catholic.edu.au

then click on 'Child Protection Training Forms' (halfway down then click on 'Volunteer Form' (halfway down page).

You will receive a confirmation email once the form has been submitted. Your details are maintained confidentially in a central database and a copy of your confirmation is emailed to the location where you are volunteering.

CENSUS

It is mandatory that parents advise the school in writing if their child is absent on any day throughout the school year. This is also a requirement if children are absent on **Census Day, Monday 18th February.** Census data is directly related to Government funding for schools and therefore the requirements are set by the Department of Education. If you know that your child will be absent on Monday 18th February, please email the school explaining their absence prior to the day. If your child is absent on the day, please email the school by 10.00 am on Monday 18th February simply advising your child's name, class and the reason for their absence.
